Attention of all the Foremen of the Chit Fund organizations in the State is invited to the reference cited, wherein the Telangana Federation of Chit Funds has brought to the notice of the undersigned certain practical problems being faced by the Chit Fund organizations while conducting the business and requested to resolve them within the ambit of the Chit Funds Act, 1982.

The issues raised by the Telangana Federation of Chit Funds; and the statutory position and clarification governing the subject are captured in the following table.

This subject is governed under section 68 of the Act. The duties vested in Section 68 are delegated to Deputy Registrar of Chits and a circular was issued to the field officers in circular bearing number CF/27858/1993, Dt. 24-12-2008. Therefore, the Deputy Registrars of Chits shall follow the law in true spirit and dispose of such request so to safeguard the interests of the subscribers and chit organization.
3	Awarding rate of interest on delayed payments and	As per Rule 17 (2) of the Chit Fund Rules, 2008, every subscriber who

5	Time gaps between PSOs and Commencement Certificate and actual date of 1 <sup>st</sup> Auction: Some selected days in a week also particular transactions only during specific days. This practice is being adopted by Assistant Registrar of Chits to their convenience only with vested interests. They tend to over look this for few abnormal favors. As the Act/ Rules are silent in this regard.	As per Section 9 of the Act, every foremen shall after all the tickets specified in the chit agreement are fully subscribed should file a declaration to that effect. As soon as the declaration is filed, the Registrar shall after satisfying himself that all the requirements relating to sanction, registration of chit and other matters have been duly complied with, shall grant a certificate of commencement to the foremen. Therefore, there is no time between these two events. It is the subjective satisfaction of the ARC. If all the conditions stipulated are complied with, the ARC shall proceed to issue Commencement Certificate without any delay. As the ARC office is a public office, it is mandatory that in all working days, the ARC office shall perform its duties.
